


12. Do believe that the Christian, as a sign of the indwelling power and grace of Christ, should keep the Ten Commandments?

Answer		

God's law and Moses' law are not the same.

So it was with the Law of Moses. It was written for the Jews only. This is why the Gentiles were not required to keep it and also why it ended at the cross. But God's law is eternal. It was here from the beginning and both Jews and Gentiles are required to obey it. Further, Scriptures says it will last forever and that heaven and earth will have to pass away before the slightest point could be changed.
